


This guide was made using a 3g iPod Touch. Later iPods, iPhones and iPads will work in a very similar way. Radyo is the free version of [Radio](#), a paid app on the App Store. The free version contains all the features you require to listen, but it does have adverts.

1. Install Radyo

You can find it in the App Store on your device by searching for "Radyo" or viewing it in iTunes [here](#).




3. Tab the + Puzzle icon Button

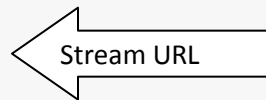


4. Enter your Steam Details

The Station Name and Description fields are for your record only, they don't need to match the server's actual details. Your Station URL should be the hostname and port only, do not include the protocol (i.e. http://).

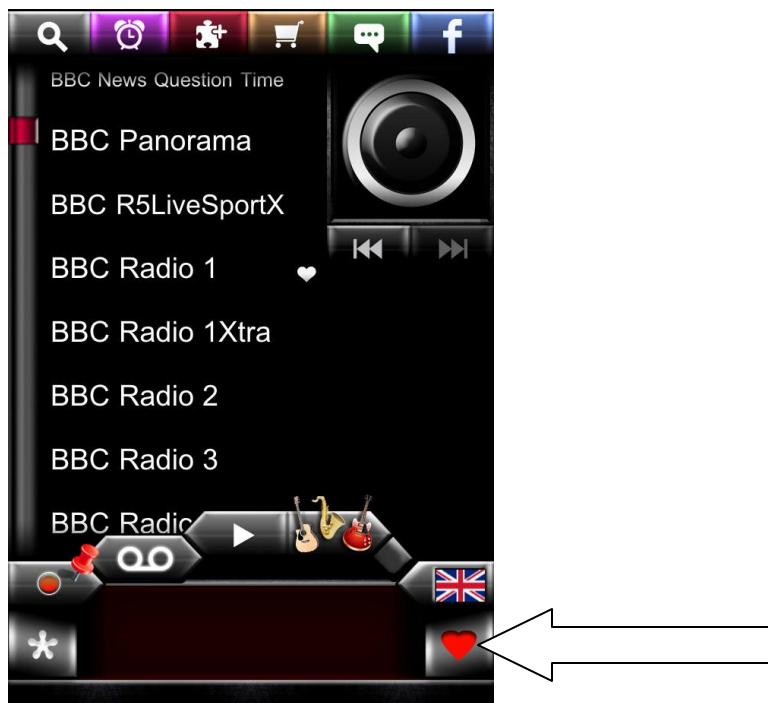
